September PTO meeting minutes were reviewed and approved. The minutes have been posted to the David PTO blog. Please note – there is a correction to the September meeting minutes. Both Sarah Smith and Melinda Norfleet will be acting Co-Presidents next school year. No further updates.

Treasurer's Update - Jill Nagy-Reynolds

The proposed budget was shared. Due to lower than hoped fundraising during the fall fundraiser, contributions to many programs had to be reduced. The only programs that were not reduced included scholarships and teacher grants.

The current proposed expenditures for the school year is \$32,794. This includes – among other things - \$1,000 for the 8th Grade /Irish Way Celebration, \$7,500 for Athletics, \$1,750 for Performing Arts and Related Arts Support, \$5,000 for academic/classroom grants, and \$4,000 for student scholarships.

The budget was approved in its current state with the hopes that further fundraising later in the year can increase PTO funding of more programs. Budget approved – Melinda Norfleet 1st, Sarah Smith 2nd.

The PTO is discussing the possibility of another fundraiser later this school year.
